Since May 2018, Claudia Warning has been Director-General at the German Federal Ministry for Economic Cooperation and Development (BMZ). Since October 2020, she has been Director-General for Asia; South-Eastern and Eastern Europe; Middle East; Latin America; civil society and churches.

Before she was Member of the Board of *Bread for the World*, the German protestant development agency. There, she was responsible for International and Domestic Programmes in more than 90 countries.

She has vast experience as leader of about twenty different organisations, voluntary as well as full-timer, among them: Executive Director of the Protestant Association for Cooperation in Development as well as Service Overseas. She was Director at Karl Kübel Foundation for Child and Family and chaired the Association of German Development and Humanitarian Aid Non-Governmental Organisations in Germany.

Before she worked at the German Commission *Justitia et Pax*, the Federal Ministry of Regional Planning, Building and Urban Development and the German Foundation for International Development.

Professor Warning studied geography in Bonn, Germany, and in Pune, India. She is honorary professor at the Rhein-Sieg University of Applied Sciences.

Professor Warning has published many papers on development issues, among them on participatory urban development, environmental and resource protection, and savings and loans systems.
